Holywell is a mountain retreat over 900 metres (3,000 feet) above sea level in the cool forests of the Blue and John Crow Mountains National Park. Just an hour's drive from Kingston, it is the perfect escape from the hustle and bustle of the capital city. Come experience the magic of the mist, the sweet sound of chirping birds sprawling lawns and relaxing hiking trails.

THINGS TO DO

The recreational area at Holywell spreads over 25 acres. With the cost of general admission, guests can enjoy nature walks on marked trails, picnics and games. Children are in for a special treat at the Kid's Zone jungle gym. Guided nature walks, bird-watching and coffee tours are offered for an additional fee.

OVERNIGHT STAYS

Holywell offers cozy cabin accommodation, complete with fire places. There are 2-bedroom, 1-bedroom and studio cabins; all with kitchenettes, hot water, bed linen and towels. Overnight guests can also use our campsites. Each campsite features a fire pit and toilet facilities. Tents are available for rent.

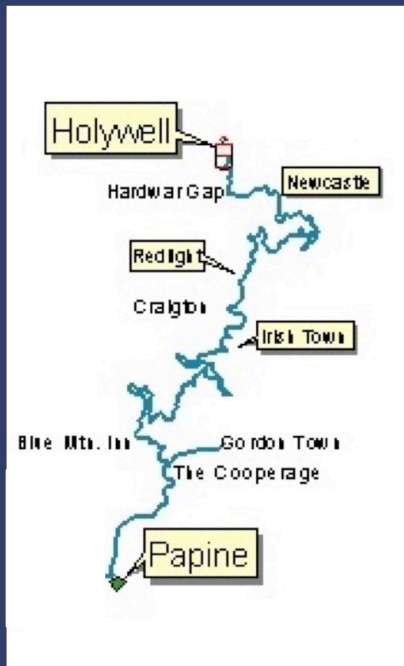
